Equatorial Cyberspace

Equatorial Cyberspace is the name of a fictional continent located between here and there. There isn't really a place called Equatorial Cyberspace.

Physical Geography and Climate

Equatorial Cyberspace consists of a mountainous interior, and flat coastal plains to the north and south of the continent. The climate of the region is generally tropical or subtropical, with the rainy season falling on the western part of the continent in September, and on the eastern part of the continent in March. The growing season typically extends from April until August, and October until January.

Rich mineral reserves (copper, diamonds, gold) have been found in parts of the continent, including and oil and gas in the central and northern regions. Some reports suggest possible gas deposits in the Gulf of Cyberia. In general, however, the continent remains underdeveloped. Transportation links are generally poor.

- Member of Commonwealth, Organization of Cyberian Nations, United Nations
- Signatory of Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide; United Nations Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment. Diamond exports certified under the Kimberley Process Certification Scheme.

- Government: civilian transitional regime
- Population: 8.4 million
- Military: 10,600, consisting of army (8,600), navy (1,000, 4 patrol craft), and airforce (1,000, 12 combat aircraft, 4 helicopters). French military base.
- Member of Francophonie, Organization of Cyberian Nations, WTO, United Nations
- Signatory of United Nations Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees; Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide; Covenant on Civil and Political Rights,

Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on their Destruction; United Nations Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment; Statutes of the International Criminal Court.

Regional Organizations

The **Cyberian Franc Bloc** was established in 1964 to promote economic cooperation between Brynania and Udem. Icasia joined in 1966, but the Bloc dissolved two years later amid differences over currency controls.

The **Organization of Cyberian Nations** was founded in 1970 to promote peaceful relations and economic cooperation among the states and peoples of Equatorial Cyberspace. In 1996, following continued civil war in Brynania and revolution in Uqamistan, the OCN announced that it would also attempt to play a larger role in peacebuilding and preventative diplomacy. To this end, a small (300 person) joint peacekeeping force was announced, consisting of contingents from Concordia, Udem and Uqamistan. This force appears to be poorly equipped and integrated however, and political differences within the OCN have thus far prevented its use in regional conflicts.

The Secretary-General of the OCN is chosen by consensus by OCN members.
